The Write Stuff – Writing Focuses:

In this term, the children will be looking at a range of different genres. The texts we will be focussing on are:

Narrative: *Mystery The Whale* by Ethan and Vita Murrow

Non-Fiction: *Speech Refugees*

Poetry: *The Malfeasance* by Alan Bold

The children will be applying grammar features taught in lessons to enhance the composition of their writing. We will do a lot of work on editing and improving their writing as this is a vital skill they will need throughout school.

Whole Class Reading focus:

The text that we will be focussing on for the Spring term for our whole class novel is: 'The boy at the back of the class' by Onjali Rauf.

This story is about the arrival of Ahmet, a nine-year old refugee child from Syria who joins an ordinary primary school in London. The narrator and her friends are curious about the new boy at the back of the class and make it their mission to become friends with him.

We will also be looking at a variety of extracts from 'Fred's teaching reading' where the children will be developing key reading skills such as inference, comprehension and prediction.

Physical Education

Computing

Kapow:

Saltwick Bay will be designing websites and learning about HTMLs whilst they will continue to learn about to stay safe online.

Science

Spring

In this term, Year 4 and Year 5 will both use the White Rose Science units.

Year 4:

Spring 1: Sound

Spring 2: Data collection and Group and classify living things

Year 5:

Spring 1: Properties of materials

Spring 2: Reproduction and Reversible and irreversible changes.

Both year groups will carry out a range of practical experiments to test theories.

Music

In this term, children will focus on the units 'Lean on me' and 'Blackbird'. They will listen and appraise the musical pieces and perform their own version.

History

Ancient Egypt:

In this term, children will plot Ancient Egypt on the map and identify key cities. They will look at ancient artifacts reconstruct the daily life of an ancient Egyptian. They will research the afterlife using the story of Osiris and Seth. They will learn about mummification and the significance of the pyramids. They will explore the lives of key Pharaohs such as Cleopatra and Tutankhamun. Also, children will explore and write using Egyptian hieroglyphics and will understand why Ancient Egypt declined and identify and explain reasons for this.

Kapow:

This half-term Saltwick Bay class will be focussing on the unit – Egyptian masks. We will be investigating different types of masks and experimenting with different designs to develop the best mask. They will be looking at range of techniques such as papier mâché.
